1. 2022 AGM

This year’s AGM will be held in Bampton Village Hall on Friday 8th April.

Doors open at 7:30 and the meeting will commence at 8:00pm.

An agenda will be published on the web site in the preceding weeks, but this year will include the following:

- Publication of League Fixtures
- Presentation of cash prizes for 2020 Virtual Competition winners.
- Draw the first round of the 8 A Side competition with audience participation.

2. AGM - Voting

Will members please note that if they wish to raise an issue at the AGM *that will result in a vote*, then they should notify us of that issue in writing/email, no later than 12:00 noon on Friday 1st April.

Any item spontaneously raised from the floor can of course be discussed, but cannot be voted on.

The Committee will consider such issues and report back to the membership at the next AGM.

Any required voting will take place using issued cards on a strictly one vote per team basis.

No proxy voting (voting on behalf of another team) is permitted.

Please arrange to send a representative to support and, if necessary, vote on the views of your team.

3. Registration & Recruitment

By the time you read this, it will be possible to register your team(s) via the web site and as you might expect, following the pandemic, we are anticipating a year of reduced membership.

We would appreciate registration as early as possible, and to avoid an excessive number of byes, we always reserve the right to put latecomers on a reserve list.

We continue to actively encourage new venues, teams and players, so if you know of anyone who has the desire *and commitment* to play in the Bampton League, let us know asap.

The absolute closing deadline for registration is 12:00 noon on Friday 1st April

The 2022 league fee will be **£50**, with a **£5 discount if paid before this year’s AGM.**

From this year, we find ourselves subject to monthly bank charges and transaction fees, so direct payment into our bank account is now critical to avoid bank costs. Receipts will be issued on request.
