



### **Beer leg league rules;**

- 1. Teams will compete in one leg of aunt sally; Normal league rules apply with the scoring and tossing. However players do not need to be signed on to play. Winners of this leg will be awarded 1 point. Total dolls hit in this leg will be added, in case of a tie at the end of the season.**
- 2. Teams can play more than 6 players, if both captains agree. Team line ups can change from the league match, but only the dolls hit by the 6 players in the league slots on the scoreboard count towards the total dolls hit.**
- 3. If the leg is tied at the end of the leg, a 3 sticker and 1 sticker will decide the winner. If the teams are still tied, it will go back to a 6 sticker and so on. Only the dolls hit in the main leg will count towards team total.**
- 4. In some cases, it may happen where the winning team hits less dolls, for example;**

In this example, Team A will win the beer leg and get the point, however, the total score will show in the league as Team A – 9, Team B – 12. This is because some teams may want to play with more than 6, but other teams do not, so to make it fair on dolls hit, this is how they will be worked out.
