1. 2026 AGM

This year's AGM will be held in the Morris Clown on **THURSDAY** 2nd April.

Any required voting will take place using issued cards on a strictly one vote per team basis.

No proxy voting (voting on behalf of another team) is permitted.

Please arrange to send a representative to support and, if necessary, vote on the views of your team.
